From the cultural delights of Bangkok to seeing the main tourist attractions by local transportation (BTS Skytrain, Chao Phraya Boat, walking & Tuk Tuk). Enjoy cycling in the Bangkok Jungle area of Bang Krajao and Ayutthaya, the former capital city of Thailand. Fly to the North of Thailand, Chiang Mai, for sightseeing and get more active with cycling and hiking to explore the nature and culture of the hilltribe villages and countryside. Ending part of the trip in the South of Thailand in Krabi and Phuket for excising activities and relaxing on the beach.

Program: -

Day 01: Bangkok – Arrival

Upon your arrival in Bangkok, deplane and follow signs to Immigration, located one level above baggage claim. Descend elevator to collect baggage. After clearing customs, proceed to the Arrival lobby and look for your sign. Our friendly representative will assist your family with luggage and help with your transfer to your comfortable hotel for check-in.

Day 02: Bangkok – Full Day Sightseeing By Public Transportations

Breakfast at the hotel

Our local guide will meet you at the hotel's lobby at 8am. The day's experience starts with a ride on the city's BTS Skytrain. Arrive close to the Chao Phraya Pier and board the Chao Phraya Tourist boat a pleasant two-layer catamaran giving phenomenal perspectives.







The boat stops close the notorious Wat Pho and the Grand Palace. Spend the rest of the morning exploring these two striking sights, finding out about the country's grand history and of the deep-rooted spiritual traditions of its people. Visit to the **Royal Grand Palace**, the nation's landmark and most praised royal monument in Thailand, with the enclosed and dazzling Wat Phra Kaew is a must. **Wat Phra Kaew**, also called the Temple of the Emerald Buddha, is well known for its Golden Chedi, its Pantheon of the Chakri Kings and its Eight Colored Tower. In Thailand, it is considered by many to be a living example of a classical Siamese Court, being the former residence of the kings of Thailand. Then short walk to visit **Wat Pho** is regarded as the first center of public education and is sometimes called 'Thailand's first university'. Mural paintings, inscriptions, and statues found in the temple educated people on various subjects such as literature, warfare, archaeology, astronomy, geology, meditation and is considered to be home of Thai traditional massages. Lunch is at a local restaurant.



Experience an afternoon trip along the bustling **Chao Phraya River** and the quiet **Thonburi Canals (Klong)** in a long tail boat, in which you can enjoy scenes of Bangkok life. We will bring you to a more traditional and serene way of living around Thonburi residential areas, away from all the skyscrapers and modern buildings of Bangkok City Centre. We will also stop by the **"Temple of Dawn"** (officially named **Wat Arun**). An ancient temple dating back to the Ayutthaya period with the imposing Khmer-style prang or tower is 104 meters tall with steep decorate with the multihued floral mosaics from broken Chinese porcelain that was used as ballast by boats coming from China. Today the temple is one of Bangkok's most iconic structures, with most remarkable visual identities on the bank of Chao Phraya River.

Then board Tuk Tuk, this world-famous three-wheel motorized open-air vehicle to visit **Wat Saket (The Golden Mount)**, this Landmark on the only hill in Bangkok, is of great significance for all followers of The Lord Buddha. 320 stairs take you up to the top for panoramic views of the Rattanakosin Island. Then take Tuk Tuk and/or BTS Skytrain back to your hotel.

Day 03: Bangkok – Half Day Jungle Bike Tour *Join-In*

Breakfast at the hotel.

We start by picking you up at your Bangkok Hotel 09:00 AM

Our guide who waits for you at the temple of Wat Klong Toey Nok, from where you will board our longtail boat and our boat operator take you by ferry you across to — Bang Kra Jao that's on the opposite bank. At our bike tour shop, we will do a fitting for your premium quality bicycle and helmet and the Bangkok jungle bike tour start!

Bangkok's green lung is a place to get a real dose of nature, it's a calming natural space in the middle of one of the world's more chaotic cities. Escape yourself in Bangkok surrounded by tranquility. Bang Kra Jao houses local communities, languid wonderland of stilt houses and gardens, temples, and markets, as well as a variety of wildlife.

Stop At: Sri Nakhon Khuean Khan Park and Botanical Garden. When it comes to cycling through the nature in Bangkok, Sri Nakhon Khuean Khan Park and the Botanical Gardens. There's an abundance of natural features to enjoy here, from pretty flowers to scenic water features such as ponds and lakes, that provide a taste of what one could expect from Thailand's amazing national parks.

Stop At: Bangkok Tree House, further enroute we bike around the small elevated pathways where we pass by many local stilt houses bamboo forests, fruit orchards and waterways. We make a visit to Bangkok Treehouse, a smart, self-contained, wood, concrete and glass tower hotel located in the middle of Bang Krajao. Here we make a coffee stop (on own expense). At the cafe you can sit and enjoy the terraces, with excellent views over the treetops to the river and in the far distance, Bangkok's skyline.

Stop At: Maha Devalaya Hindu Temple, surrounded by jungle palms, a colorful statue of the god Ganesha can be found in the only Hindu temple on Bang Kachao. A huge Ganesha (elephant god).

Stop At: Bang Nam Phueng Floating Market

*On weekends, the tour also includes a visit to the local Bang Nam Phueng Floating Market. Open on weekends, it is one of the biggest markets to visit around Bangkok. There are many places try out a variety of snacks and desserts as you stroll from stall to stall.

Stop At: Bang Kachao. We stop in at a local restaurant to eat authentic and delicious Thai food. *Menu: Stir fried chicken in basil leaves, sweat sour pork, thai-style omelet, mixed vegetables in oyster sauce & Tom Yam Soup. *Vegetarian meal is available too.

After lunch we head back to the river and do the boat crossing where our car will take you back to your hotel.

Day 04: Bangkok – Ayutthaya Bicycle Tour *Join-In* – Bang Pa-In Summer Palace

Breakfast at the hotel.





Pick you up at your Bangkok Hotel 08:00 AM and transfer approximate an hour to explorer **Ayutthaya City** & it's ruin. To truly appreciate the history in Thailand, no holiday would be complete without a visit to Ayutthaya. This historic city was *the second capital of the Kingdom of Siam*, there are 34 kings to govern the territory until the end of it by an invasion of the nearby territory in 2310 B.E. It results in Ayutthaya Empire has stayed long about 417 years and a prosperous international trading port, from 1350 until razed by the Burmese in 1767. The ruins of the old city now form the Ayutthaya Historical Park, an archaeological site that contains palaces, Buddhist temples, monasteries and statues.

During our Ayutthaya bicycle excursion, you will get a good impression of the once mighty capital of Siam. Our first stop is at Pom Phet or "Diamond Fortress", one of the sixteen fortresses along the city walls of Ayutthaya. Although partially destroyed, the fort still conveys what must have been ancient travelers first impressions of the Kingdom of Siam. We continue our Ayutthaya bicycle adventure and cycle through local neighborhoods and pass so-called "Roti Road". Dozens of vendors offer bags of the colorful "Roti Sai Mai", one of the most famous Thai desserts in Ayutthaya – threads of twirled palm sugar wrapped in a round unleavened bread.

We cycle through the quiet Somdet Phra Srinakarinda Park to Chedi Phra Si Suriyothai, a memorial for the first heroine in Thai history, and make a short photo stop here. Then we ride further along the river and observe the daily life of the local people living on the river banks. We stop at a Muslim community where they make handicraft woven wind mobiles from palm leaves in the shape of a carp, "Pla Tapian Bai Lan".

The tour brings us then to the world-renowned Ayutthaya Historical Park, an UNESCO World Heritage Site since 1991. Here we see the ruins of the old temples. We stop at Wat Phra Sri Sanphet which was the most important temple of Ayutthaya and situated within the Royal Palace grounds. The next stop is at Wat Mahathat, best known for its photogenic Buddha's head entwined within the roots of a tree. It is one of the most recognizable images from Thailand and can be found on many post cards and travel books.

We continue our Ayutthaya bicycle ride to "Chao Phrom Market" and walk with our bicycle over the market. This busy market has been around since Ayutthaya was the capital of Siam. It houses a large concentration of amulet shops, food stalls and vendors selling all kinds of wares. We take a ferry back to cross the Pasak river and within a few minutes we are back at our office where the tour ends.

*During the trip we make regular stops for sightseeing and to provide you with drinking water/soft drink and a Thai snack.

*Anyone able to ride a bicycle can join this Ayutthaya bicycle excursion as it is designed to be enjoyable, educational and fun and is not too demanding on the legs!

*As you will visit ancient temples you are expected to dress respectfully. We recommend you to wear longer shorts (knees covered) and to have your shoulders covered when we enter the temples.



Lunch is at a local restaurant.

After lunch, drive to Bangkok. Enroute visit **Bang Pa-In Summer Palace**. The site was first used by the royal court as a summer retreat in the 17th century. However, the Palace was destroyed with the fall of Kingdom of Ayutthaya and was restored by King Rama IV in the mid-19th century. Most of the buildings that exist today date from the reign of King Rama V, who regularly spent his summers there. The structures represent a variety of architectural styles, set in a large park around ponds and waterways.

Day 05: Bangkok – Fly To Chiang Mai – Half Day City Temples & Doi Suthep Temple

Breakfast at the hotel and check-out.

Meet our guide and take a private transfer to Bangkok Airport for take a flight to Chiang Mai. (*recommended flight TG104 time: 10:15-11:30hrs / Excluded*).

Upon arrival Chiang Mai Airport, meet our guide and take a private transfer to your hotel for check in.

Afternoon, visit the most sacred temple in the North of Thailand: **Wat Phrathat Doi Suthep** is the most sacred temple in Chiang Mai and contains a holy relic of the Lord Buddha. Tucked away in the mountains at an elevation of 1,056 meters (3,520 feet), the temple can be reached by the carved mythical Naga Serpent Staircase. The temple offers an exhilarating view of Chiang Mai city and its surrounding countryside. Then return drive to the city and visit **Wat Phrasing**, which is home of the beautiful Lai Kham chapel with its exquisite woodcarving and northern style murals. We will then go to **Wat Chedi Luang** and its enormous Pagoda (which was partially destroyed by an earthquake in 1545) before heading to **Wat U-Mong** This old temple (established in 1296) is now widely known as a meditation centre devout Buddhists from around the world visit to practice amid its peaceful atmosphere and minimalism structures. Around the area you also find numerous historical artifacts and architectures, such as Asok Pillar, which is devoted to an Indian King Asok Maharaja who was a devout Buddhist, and U-Mong, an ancient tunnel-like architecture built to create a near-silent ambience for better meditation practice.



Note: Please dress respectfully by not wearing sleeveless T-shirts, shorts or strapless sandals, when visiting Wat Phrathat Doi Suthep

CHIANG MAI STREET EATS BY TUK TUK Private Service / Time: 16.30 20:30 hrs.

Highlights:

- Take a local transport "Tuk-Tuk" (pick-up & drop-off hotel in town)
- Experience on tasting local food in Chiang Mai town
- Visit the religion relics places in Chiang Mai town
- A glass of beverage at Xanadu Restaurant with scenic Chiang Mai view

Depart from the hotel by local transport **"Tuk-Tuk"** to Chiang Mai gate local market for street food. Just outside the old walled city center of Chiang Mai, the **Wat Lok Molee** is one of the city's older temples. The temple that is also known as the Wat Lok Moli houses one of the largest and most impressive chedis in Chiang Mai.

After your experience with Chiang Mai local shopping, take a ride to the night market on **Chang Puak Gate** or North Gate is always busy and offers a great range of authentic Thai cuisine. Try the stewed pork leg from the famous vendor with the cowboy hat who's had visits from the likes of Anthony Bourdain. Taste Bua Loi, or floating lotus, is a warm fresh coconut milk broth with teeny pandan-laced glutinous rice flour balls swimming around. Take a ride with Tuk-Tuk to see **Chiang Mai nightlife** around old city, **visit 3-Kings monument**, Wat Chedi Luang. Let's celebrate with your friends and family, spend the night and enjoy the beautiful Chiang Mai view with a glass of beverage at **Xanadu Restaurant** before return to the hotel in Chiang Mai town.

Day 06: Chiang Mai – Full Day Cycling Culture Trip

Breakfast at hotel

09h00: Met and transferred by an English-Speaking Guide from the hotel to Trekker camp, a centre of cycling tour & gears where briefly information about a cycling route as well as the instructions of using the mountain bike will be explained.

09h15: Start cycling from here via Padad-Singhakam route passing Padad Tai village along the Ping's Riverside then continues through the 2nd ring road crossing Koh Klang Bridge (Kourmung).

09h30: Stop at Wat Koh Klang, an important temple of this community.

10h30: Proceed cycling to the vegetable's plantation belonged to the villagers which is the trend of sustainable agriculture. Over there, the land has been reclaimed without using any chemical fertilizer. Instead, the farmers prevent and eliminate pests by using natural process. Explore around to see plantations of cabbage, chili, corn, eggplant, pea, shallot, and garlic for examples. Next, continue cycling a bit more to see various types of fruits such as banana, mango, and etc. Also if you love to join the gardener' activities likes cultivating, watering, and fishing, these are something quite interesting to do as well!

11h30: Start cooking local Thai food joining with the host (the same person who owns vegetable plantation) then enjoy lunch amidst the countryside atmosphere at Pa Kaew's house. Also taste different kinds of luscious seasonal fruits for examples coconut, rose apple, mango, longan, banana and papaya. Learn how people live in cozy and simply style (spend about 2 hours in this place).

14h30: Leave for the Informational Centre of Wiang Kum Kam to get some background information of the ruin city. Wiang Kum Kam is the ancient underground empire of Lanna kingdom built by King Mang Rai where many ruin archaeological excavations and sites for instances temples, Buddha images and old potteries have been discovered.

15h00: Further biking through the village viewing Wiang Kum Kam in general. Make a first stop at Wat Chang Kum (also known as Wat Khan Tom), the first archaeological site which was found in 1984. Take chance to





participate a blessing ceremony performed by a Buddhist monk in this temple.

15h45: Keep on traveling to Wat E-Kang, Wat Nhan Chang, Wat Pu Beai, Wat Pra Thart Khaow, and the last temple, Wat Chedi Liem (also known as Wat Ku Kam Luang). Appreciate the enormous facet pagoda restored many times both by the Thai and Burmese consequently which shows a lot of mixture on the architecture's style on the Chedi itself. Relax and freshen up before cycling back to the city.

16h30: Return to Trekker camp and transferred to the hotel.

EVENING KHANTOKE DINNER WITH THAI CULTURAL SHOWS Private Transfer Service / Time: 18.00 - 21:00 hrs.

Khantoke Dinner at Old Chiangmai Cultural Center invites everyone to experience the atmosphere of the Northern Thai culture, taste the cuisine, and enjoy the unique Fon Ram dance performances. The original Khantoke Dinner has been served for over 50 years. We are pleased to welcome everyone to the warm city of Chiang Mai. Each Khantoke set includes 9 dishes, such as Hang Ley Curry, Kaeng Khae, Laab Kua, Deep-fried Crispy Chicken, Nam Prik Noom, Nam Prik Ong, Kab Moo, Sticky Rice, and Fresh/Boiled Vegetables. The dishes are served on the Khantoke tray, and each set can serve up to 4 people, accompanied by a traditional Lanna dance performance that showcases the unique local culture.

Day 07: Chiang Mai – Local Market – Karen Hilltribe Village – Elephant Feeding And Bathing

MORNING: Depart by truck to the North of Chiang Mai. A short stop will be made at Mae Malai local market to purchase some foods and vegetables needed during the trek. Stop at Mok Fah Waterfall for swimming and relaxation. Transfer by truck to Karen village.





LUNCH: Lunch at the village, guide will show his cooking skill by preparing lunch for the group.

AFTERNOON: Trek about 3.5 hour to another Karen hill tribe village at Bann Pa Kao Lam.

NIGHT: Walk around the village to see their local lifestyle. Feeding the Elephant and bathing Elephant in the river. Dinner and overnight at the Karen village. There's usually a camp fire with some entertainment (Jokes? Games? Funny Stories) lead by the guide after dinner.

Day 08: Karen Hilltribe Village – Bamboo Raft – Lahu Hilltribe Village – Shan Village – Chiang Mai

MORNING: Breakfast at the village. Trek about 1 hour to the rafting point. Take a bamboo raft along the Taeng River through many rapids for 2.5 hours (depend on water level) to Shan village, Bann Sob Kai. On the way stop at Lahu hill tribe village at Bann Pong Ngan.

LUNCH: Late lunch at Shan village.

AFTERNOON: Transfer back to Chiang Mai by local truck and transfer to hotel on reservation.

Upon your arrival Krabi Airport, deplane and follow signs to collect baggage. Then proceed to the Arrival lobby and look for your sign. Our friendly representative will assist your family with luggage and help with your transfer to your comfortable hotel for check-in.

Day 10: Krabi – Full Day Kayaking At Ao Tha Lane *Join-In*

Ao Tha Lane the fascinating canyon, lagoon and limestone historical painting will make you amazing. Kayaking will consume your energy to the fun adventure. You will enjoy paddling the kayak through mangrove atmosphere. Along the way, you will get to see the ecological abundance in mangrove area and sandbank. Plus, for more exciting experience, you might have chance to see many kinds of animals like monkeys, mud keepers, crabs and shells.

Tour Program;

08:30AM: Pick up from your hotel and depart to Ao Tha Lane.

10:00AM: Arrive at Tha Lane pier, short break and kayak training. Start to paddle through 500ft channel, excellent opportunity for nature spotting, monkeys, eagles, lizards etc.

12:00AM: Lunch

13:00PM: Time for swimming & relaxing on the white sand beach.

16:30PM: Transfer back to your hotel.

FULL DAY 4 ISLANDS BY SPEED BOAT OR LONGTAIL BOAT Join-in Service / Time: 08:30 - 15:30 hrs.

08:30AM: Pick up from your hotel in Krabi

09:00AM: Depart from pier by speed boat / longtail boat to visit the following Island &beaches:

- **Phranang cave:** is a beautiful beach with Limestone Mountain and a cliff. At the end of the path has a cave that is surrounded by white sand and a clear sea. In the morning will be full of Thai and foreign tourists. It is a good location for swimming or enjoying other activities on the beach such as Climbing, Sunbathing, Padding board and seeing the sunset.

Tub Island: Relaxing the white sandy linkage between Tap Island and Chicken Island at low tide.
Poda Island: Relax for sunbathing. It is unique in that it has a small island. The island looks like a sailboat located in front of the beach. Ko Poda is surrounded by beaches on 3 sides except the west side, which is the side that receives windy waves and is a high rocky cliff. There are white sandy beaches around the island and clear water that is suitable for swimming. The island's coastline has a variety of intact coral reefs.
Chicken Island - Enjoy swimming & snorkeling among coral reefs and Fish and Lunch time.

Day 12: Krabi – Phuket City & Old Town Tour

Breakfast at the hotel and check-out.

Meet our guide and transfer to Phuket (approximately 3 hours by drive), check in at hotel in Phuket.

Afternoon, explore the beauty of nature, history and architecture of Phuket's oldtown and try out Phuket specialty and will serve you the best of Phuket experience. The trip features to most southern of Phuket Island to **Promthep Cape**, it looks like a





curve cape extending into the Andaman Sea. It is surrounded by palm trees and grasses. On the right side is Nai Harn Beach and Koh Man. On the left side, you will see a small beach called Nai Yah beach. Next to visit the **Big Buddha** is one of the most important and revered landmarks on the island. The huge image sits on top of the Nakkerd Hills, this buddha image is a stunning piece of contemporary art which measures in at 25.45 meters wide and 45 meters in height. The image is made from reinforced concrete and covered in white and jade 'Suriyakanta' marble which also affords great views over Chalong Bay from the front face of the image and of Kata, Karon and other smaller bays to the rear. Then a visit to the acclaimed **Chalong Temple**; famed for its Portuguese architecture. Loved by both Asian and foreign visitors, the temple's highlight is a wax sculpture of the abbot housed in an air-conditioned Thai-style house next to the chapel. Then drive to **Phuket Old Town**, visit beauty elegant architecture buildings reflecting European influence in the early 20th, take you back to a charm of a century ago.


