#### FULL DAY HIGHLIGHTS OF BANGKOK





#### Private Service / Time: 08.00 - 17:00 hrs.

A visit to the **Royal Grand Palace**, the nation's landmark and most praised royal monument in Thailand, with the enclosed and dazzling **Wat Phra Kaew** is a must. Wat Phra Kaew, also called the Temple of the Emerald Buddha, is well known for its Golden Chedi, its Pantheon of the Chakri Kings and its Eight Coloured Tower. In Thailand, it is considered by many to be a living example of a classical Siamese Court, being the former residence of the kings of Thailand. Then short walk to visit **Wat Pho** is regarded as the first centre of public education and is sometimes called 'Thailand's first university'. Mural paintings, inscriptions, and statues found in the temple educated people on various subjects such as literature, warfare, archaeology, astronomy, geology, meditation and is considered to be home of Thai traditional massages. Here, you will enjoy a 30-minute Thai massage as an excellent break after a morning sightseeing. Lunch is at a local restaurant.



Experience an afternoon trip along the bustling Chao Phraya River and the quiet **Thonburi Canals (Klong)** in a long tail boat, in which you can enjoy scenes of Bangkok life. We will bring you to a more traditional and serene way of living around Thonburi residential areas, away from all the skyscrapers and modern buildings of Bangkok City Centre. We will also stop by the "Temple of Dawn" (officially named **Wat Arun**).

Finally, a visit to the **Flower and Vegetable market** will round off this day. Located close to the Chao Phraya River, the place pictures a rural piece of Bangkok where a vast selection of all kinds of flowers, especially orchids and tropical flowers, can be found. Also, observe how the merchants create very special flower garlands. This Bangkok day tour ends at the **Golden Mountain** 

\*Please note that photography is permitted in the Royal Palace Grounds and in the compounds of the Emerald Buddha Temple, but not inside the buildings. Also, note that the chapel is a national shrine and that you will be required to wear proper attire (no bare shoulders, knees or strapless-heel shoes). Shoes must be removed before entering the temple buildings as a matter of respect.

#### FULL DAY A DAY IN A LIFE TO AYUTTHAYA Private Service / Time: 07.30 - 17:00 hrs.

We are delighted to showcase Ayutthaya in the upcoming edition of The MICHELIN Guide in Thailand. The city's dining scene is an impressive fusion of old and new – with long-running restaurants, new eateries in both old renovated buildings and modern ones, attractive coffee shops and cafés; to both on-land. The city's vast culinary offerings, together with its rich historical and cultural background. **Ayutthaya Historical Park**, a UNESCO World Heritage Site. With a personal guide to lead the way, you'll see temples, a Buddhist monastery, and learn about the ancient capital city of Thailand. This private Ayutthaya tour includes pickup and drop-off at Bangkok hotel, entrance fees, and a Thai lunch, as well as the fun, flexible experience of a private guide.

Explorer through **Wat Phra Sri Sanphet**, is an important landmark in Ayutthaya where you will visit ancient ruin of Grand Palace and its temples including monk chat and make merit. **Wat Mahathat** an unseen tourist attraction where you could see buddha head enshrine in the three. These temples also enshrine buddha lyric from the past 600 years. Stops and experiences how the local people making famous product **"candy cotton"** this is in Thai we called " ROTI ". We will let you learn how they make it and will also let you try it. We would like to take you somewhere tourist not usually go. Here is an old ruin temple (**Wat Kudidao**) where we can share with your storytelling from local people and also other stories about Ayutthaya that you could not find on google or any travel book.

#### HALF DAY MAEKLONG TRAIN MARKET & DAMNOEN SADUAK FLOATING MARKET Private Service / Time: 07.00 - 11:30 hrs.

This interesting half-day tour will take you to the rural yet world-famous **Maeklong Train Market** folding up and the stalls being packed away in front of your eyes. Explore the market like a local and see the stalls stacked with fruits, vegetables and seafood. Continue to explore **Damnoen Saduak Floating Market**, situated around 100 kilometres west of Bangkok. It is generally known as Klong Ton Khem Floating Market or Damnoen Saduak Floating Market. Damnoen Saduak has officially three floating markets. A narrow canal flanked with food stalls and souvenir shops forms the principal market. Photographers at Ton Kem will get their best shots from the bridge which crosses over the canal and from the shed on the right. Paddle boat 30mins inside the floating market is included in the tour price. Nowadays, the market is bustling with activity from very early in the morning until about 11.00 am. For those who want to buy some memorabilia here, do not forget to bargain!

#### **EVENING BANGKOK STREET EATS BY TUK TUK** Private Service / Time: 16.30 - 21:00 hrs.

Starting you Bangkok night tour. You will travel by Tuk-Tuk, this world-famous three-wheel motorized open-air vehicle and explore Bangkok's markets, temples and food, under the night lights. While most tourists will visit Bangkok's landmarks during the day time, Thailand Journeys offers the incredible opportunity to enter these places at an original and unique time of the day: we will stop at markets including the Wanglang daily market in Bangkok Noi district next to Siriraj Hospital and Chao Phraya River in Bangkok's Thonburi side. The name "Wanglang Market" means rear palace market, because of its location. As we go, we will stop to sample some of the best food in Bangkok.

During journey, we will tour **Wanglang Market** then take a public boat across to Tha-Chang pier to meet Tuk-Tuk driver at the meeting point nearby. It's really amazing time to take a great shot around Wat Pho and Grand Palace in the night. Continue to **China town** (locally named Yaowarat road) – transforms into one of the largest street food spots in the world. Popular offerings include dim sum, oyster omelette's, flat noodles in a pepper broth, and lots of fresh seafood. There are also many exotic fruits on offer, as well as homemade ice cream. Get a surprising panoramic view of Chinatown and beyond (all the way to the Chao Phraya River) with one especially cocktail drink at Sky View 360. It takes about 2 hours for this rotating restaurant to complete a full round and you barely notice any movement. This viewpoint is not well-known, but it's a great place to take an air-conditioned break after a tiring exploration.
