Program: -

Day 01: Bangkok – Arrival

Upon your arrival in Bangkok, deplane and follow signs to Immigration, located one level above baggage claim. Descend elevator to collect baggage. After clearing customs, proceed to the Arrival lobby and look for your sign. Our friendly representative will assist your family with luggage and help with your transfer to your comfortable hotel for check-in.

Day 02: Bangkok – Welcome meeting - Klong (canal tour) – Wat Pho

Buffet Breakfast will be served at the hotel (time: 06:30-10:30hrs morning).

After Breakfast at the hotel, get to know fellow traveler at 9:00 AM and meet with your Trip expert who will be with you from here to the end of the trip. He/She will do welcome speech and spend around 45 minutes to do tour orientation.

Travel by motor launch on the picturesque Chao Phraya River and canals, or Klongs, to observe the serene family homes and temples along the waterways. You will pass the famous Royal Barges, excellent samples of Thai craftsmanship and stop at Wat Pho, one of the oldest and largest temples in Bangkok.

Afternoon is at Leisure in Bangkok.

Optional Evening Bangkok at night by Tuk-Tuk tour. (Book in advance or ask your Trip expert for more information)

Day 03: Bangkok – Ayutthaya Day trip

Breakfast at the hotel and make a trip to Ayutthaya: former Kingdom of Siam by one hour drive.

Explore through **Wat Phra Sri Sanphet**, is an important landmark in Ayutthaya where you will visit ancient ruin of **Grand Palace** and its temples including monk chat and make merit. Wat Mahathat an unseen tourist attraction where you could see buddha head enshrine in the three.

These temples also enshrine buddha Relic from the past 600 years. **Kudi Dao** is a restored temple ruin situated off the city island in the eastern area of Ayutthaya. Enjoy local lunch at the restaurant.

Stops and experiences how the local people making famous product **Cotton candy**, this is in Thai we call **ROTI**. We will let you learn how they make it and will also let you try it. We would like to take you somewhere tourist not usually go. Here is an old ruin temple (**Wat Kudidao**) where we can share with your storytelling from local people and also other stories about Ayutthaya that you could not find on google or any travel book. We head back to Bangkok after the tour.

Day 04: Bangkok – Siem Reap by Overland drive


This morning, check out from the hotel and get ready for road trip headed east to Thai – Cambodia land border, after immigration formalities, we continue our drive to Siem Reap.

(Approximately driving from Bangkok to Siem Reap is 7 hours)

Note: Prepare your E-visa before or check with our Travel experts beforehand)

After some refreshment at hotel, In the evening, make a visit to lively Siem Reap **Pub Street** where you can explore opportunities to bring some great memories strolling through souvenirs shops, pop-up exotic snacks shops and dinner options.

Day 05: Siem Reap – Sunrise over Angkor Wat and Ancient ruins tour

Early this morning, hop on a local **Ramork** (similar to the Thai tuktuk) and be taken to a special sightseeing tour of the famous **Angkor Wat**. Built during the reign of King Suryavarman II in the early 12th century, Angkor Wat is constructed following the model of the temple mountain symbolizing Mount Meru, the home of the gods. Inside the temple, the walls are covered with stone carvings and bas-reliefs depicting Hindu mythology and the wars Suryavarman II fought during his reign. Angkor Wat is well known for the more than 2,000 Apsara dancers decorating the temple. Construction is thought to have taken around thirty years of intensive labor. Today, Angkor Wat is figured on Cambodia's national flag as the temple symbolizes the soul of the Khmer people. Lunch is served at the restaurant near Angkor Wat.

This afternoon, explore **ancient city of Angkor Thom**. This is the last capital of the Great Khmer Empire under the reign of Jayavarman VII and the city is surrounded by an 8m high wall, drawing a perfect square. Enter through the ancient South Gate, an impressive stone gate carved with Elephants and four giant faces.

From here, continue to **Bayon Temple** in the exact center of the city. This 12th century masterpiece is a study in grandeur and is well-known for its 54 towers with enigmatic faces representing the 54 provinces of the Great Khmer Empire. **The Terrace of the Elephants and the Terrace of the Leper King** are also must-visits as they are both known for their intricate bas-reliefs.

End your day visiting the temples of the Small Circuit. The most illustrious of these is Ta Prohm, built in the mid-12th to early 13th centuries. Ta Prohm is unique in that it has been left largely as it was found: overgrown by jungle trees and vines, with many parts of the temple crumbling to the ground. This makes the 'Tomb Raider Temple' one of the most picturesque and memorable of the Angkor temples. The visit will also include Banteay Kdei, a Buddhist monastery from the late 12th Century, and Srah Srang, also known as the 'pool of ablutions'.

Day 07: Siem Reap – Phnom Penh

Breakfast at the hotel and check-out.

Today begin 5 hrs scenic drive to Phnom Penh, along the drive enjoy the rural scenery of Cambodia, making stops at Skuon known for its abundance in exotic fruits and snacks, wander around this little rest-stop to witness what local specialties are picked by locals on their drive.

Enroute stop at local family for home-cooked lunch experience, interact with local hosts to learn Khmer culture and traditions.

Arriving in the afternoon, check-in to the hotel for some refreshment.

Later join **Orientation walking tour** led by our Trip expert to understand history and culture of Phnom Penh, pick riverside rooftop restaurant for some drinks and dinner.

Day 08: Phnom Penh – Killing Fields & Toul Sleng Genocide Museum

Breakfast will be served at the hotel. Today we will escort you on guided excursion.

Guided Excursion to Killing Fields and Toul Sleng Genocide Museum

After Independence from French colony, Cambodia was divided by different political agendas and unwanted dragging in to Vietnam war finally led to the rise of communism, it finally resulted in authoritarian rule of Pol Pot: leader of Khmer Rouge, his brutal regime took over 3 million lives, war is still bitter to many but today former execution and interrogation sites named **Killing fields** and Toul Sleng Genocide Museum are places that history is retold.

After guided excursion, we will return to city, afternoon is free at leisure. **Optional activities** as follows:

Grand Palace visit: showcase of Khmer art and craftsmanship Cyclo tour of City: Ride along the streets and Boulevards, passing friendly locals and city landmarks

Overnight in Phnom Penh. Meals: Breakfast Included

Day 09: Phnom Penh – Ho Chi Minh City by flight

Breakfast at the hotel, free at leisure and enjoy the hotel facilities.

Check-out and meet your Thailand Journeys Tour leader and take a private transfer to Phnom Penh Airport for your flight to **Ho Chi Minh city** (*recommended flight/ Earlier flight VN 921 - (Vietnam Airlines) time:* 13:50-15:00hrs / included).

Upon your arrival in **Tan Son Nhat** Airport, perform immigration formalities and drive to hotel for check-in.

Note: Most nationalities receive single entry visa exemption but please check before your status or prepare visa beforehand.

After check-in and refreshment at the hotel, join the guided walking orientation of Ho Chi Minh city, a sprawling, characteristic and busy metropolis with many stories to tell.

Day 10: Ho Chi Minh City – Cu Chi Tunnels

Breakfast will be served at the hotel. Today we will escort you on guided excursion to understand Vietnam which many stories are untold of.

Guided Excursion to Cu Chi Tunnels; War Memorial Museum

South and North Vietnam war with international involvement is known worldwide but the stories of this village outside of Ho Chi Minh City that defended their families and beliefs underground and above were never untold. Once Cu Chi village was a farming community that later turned Vietcong who in the South Vietnam built intricate and functional tunnel systems. Our Half-day excursion will provide you with insightful knowledge on the stories and history.

Lunch is served at local restaurant.

After guided excursion, we will return to city, afternoon is free at leisure. Optional activities as follows:

War Remnants Museum: Largest collection of photos, artworks, documents and War vehicles and Shopper's paradise "Ben Thanh market"

Overnight in Ho Chi Minh city Meals: Breakfast, Lunch Included

Day 11: Ho Chi Minh City - Mekong Delta Tour

Breakfast will be served at the hotel. Today we will escort you on guided excursion to **Mekong Delta**, resourceful and cultural region where you can observe rural Vietnam.

Day 12:

Ho Chi Minh City - Da Nang - Hoi An by flight

Upon your arrival in **Da Nang** Airport, drive to hotel in Hoi An for check-in.

After some refreshment at hotel, Your Trip Leader and Local Expert will organize **Orientation Walk and walking tour of the ancient town center** to visit the former merchants' homes, the 400-year-old Japanese Covered Bridge and the colorful market.

Lunch is on your own in Hoi An Old Town. Afternoon is free at leisure.

Day 14:

Hoi An - Hue

Breakfast at the hotel, and prepare to make 4 hrs. drive past coastal road by East Sea, picturesque hill views with a stop at Bunker Hill once it was Border check-point between North and South Vietnam, then continue the mesmerizing scenery along the way to Hue, a quintessential town in Central Vietnam.

Guided Excursion to Khai Dinh Tomb and Bunker hill

Hue is tucked away gem of Vietnam in Central Vietnam, once the Imperial capital by Perfume River which hosted scholars from all across Vietnam notably hometown of Uncle Ho, its tranquility, history and culture represents Vietnamese ways of life. Today visit Khai Dinh Tomb adorned in neoclassical architecture, mausoleum of Emperor Khai Dinh who was the twelfth Emperor of the Nguyễn dynasty of Vietnam. And make a stop at Bunker hill where you will learn about the DMZ and wars between North and South of Vietnam.

After excursion, return to hotel or discover what Hue walking street night scene offers,

Day 15:

Hue - Hanoi by Overnight train

Spend the day at leisure and check out from hotel. As a suggestion head down to Hue's Imperial Tombs and Royal houses of last **Nguyễn Dynasty**, deeply influenced by East Asian customs or get a little adventurous on the escorted bike-taxi to explore alleys, pagoda and historic remains.

Today is your free day at leisure before catching Overnight Sleeper train (**ETA: 15:05/1545**) to give deep into its way of life. You can choose to relax on your own or consider optional activities as follows:

Citadel or Imperial city which once resided Emperors of the Nguyễn dynasty of Vietnam. Thien Mu Pagoda: known for traditional Vietnamese architecture Buddhist monastery, impressive Bonsai Garden and holy monk who drove down to Ho Chi Minh city for protest

The Perfume River: enjoy Dragon along the river

Escorted Bike-taxi half-day tour of hidden Alleys, colorful incent sticks workshops, and Thanh Toan Bridge

Your Trip expert is standby to assist whatever you need today.

In the afternoon, hop on the Overnight sleeper train to Hanoi for visit to Ha Long Bay, (Approximately traveling time 13 Hours).

Excursion to Ha Long Bay 2 Days / 1 Night

Set off your journey from Hanoi for a 2.5 hrs drive to Ha Long Bay including a 20-minutes stop on the way. Arrive at the jetty in Ha Long City towards noon and proceed with check-in formalities. After a welcome onboard, lunch will be served while cruising towards the bay itself. In the afternoon, enjoy some visits and/or activities (depending on each boat's itinerary) or just spend some time relaxing on board. Towards the end of the day the boat sets anchor for the night among the karst formations. Dinner is served on board.
